# Dress Code

Correct uniform is:

- Scout shirt
- Troop necker
- Scout trousers
- Black shoes
- Scout belt
- Correct troop badges



## **Scout shirt**

This is a great example of how to smartly wear your scout shirt. It is neatly tucked in, the sleeves are not rolled up, all buttons including top are all fastened and all badges are neatly sewed on in the right places.



## **Scout trousers** **and belt**

A smart pair of trousers are always:

- The right size
- Neatly ironed
- All pockets fastened properly
- They are clean

A good belt is :

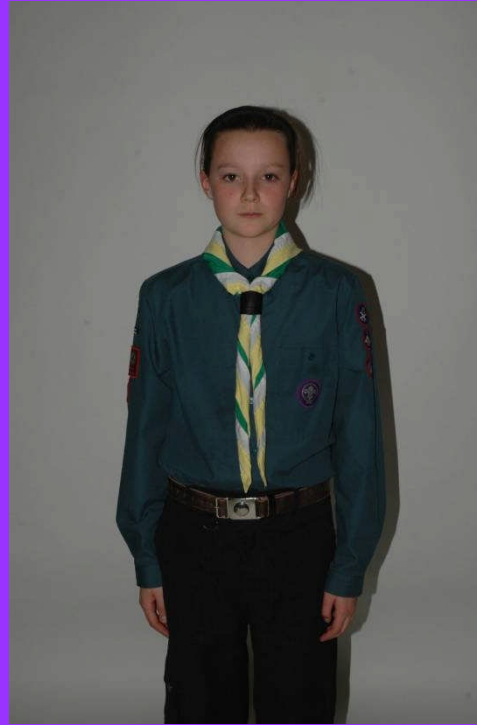
- The right size
- Tight enough
- Through all the trouser loops
- Fastened properly



## Necker

A smart Necker has to be:

- Twisted neatly.
- Ironed neatly.
- Fastened to the top with a leather woggle.
- Must have troop badge on the tip of the Necker.



# How to roll a necker

1. Hold your necker at the two tips, with the troop badge facing away from you.
2. Start twisting the tips towards you.
3. Stop when you have an approximate hand span length tail.
4. Then bring the two tips together, and hold it upside-down.
5. Then put it around your neck with the troop badge at the back facing away from you.
6. Finally keep your necker together by pulling your woggle up.
